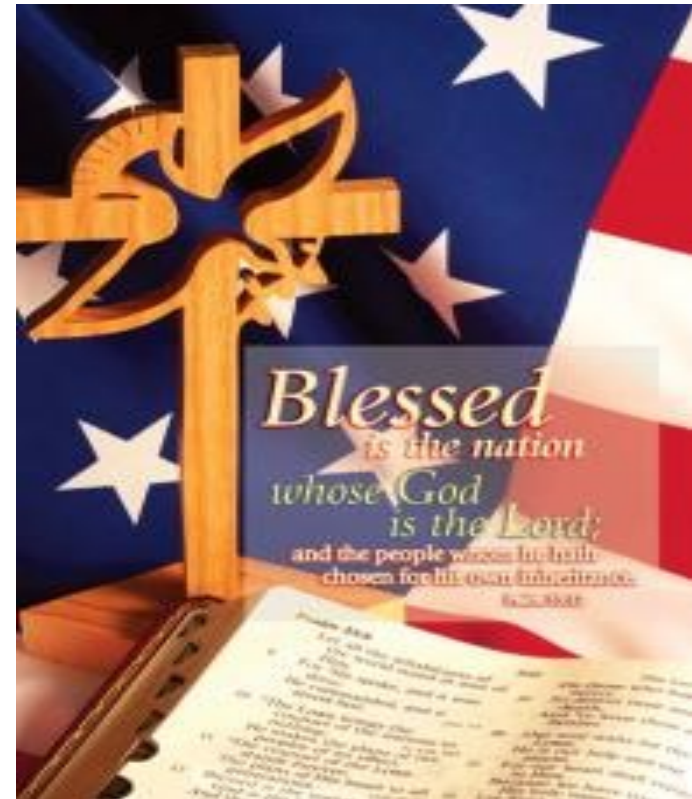

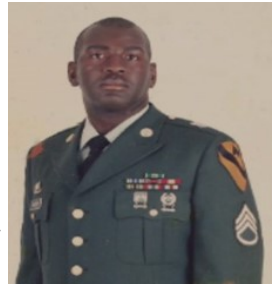

Reverend SSG (Retired) Gregory Rodgers



Reverend, SSG (Retired) Gregory Rodgers was born to Mae Cola Rodgers and the late Louis Mitchell Rodgers in Creswell, North Carolina. He is the third son and fifth child of twelve siblings. He graduated from Creswell High School in 1977 and immediately enlisted into the United States Army as a Motor Transport Operator. His military education consists of, Army Training Management Systems, Diesel Bus and Bus Orientation Course, Primary Leadership Development Course, Basic Non-Commissioned Officers Course, Pre-Command Course, and other courses hosted on the Army Learning Management and Enterprises Lifelong Learning Systems.

Throughout his military career his assignments as a Heavy/Light Wheeled Vehicle Operator consisted of three tours in Germany. The first with Eighth (8th) ID, Mainz, Germany, and the 2nd and 3rd with Thirty-Seventh (37th) Trans Group, Stuttgart, Germany. His state side assignments were Ft. Lee and Ft. Eustis, Virginia, and Ft. Hood Texas. His career was highlighted by two combat deployments to Southwest Asia during the Liberation of Kuwait.

Reverend Rodgers' decorations and awards include the Meritorious Service Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal (6th Award), National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal with One Bronze Star Device, Kuwait Liberation Medal, and the Kuwait Liberation Medal-Saudi Arabia. He wears the Expert Marksmanship Badge for the Rifle and Pistol and earned both Driver and Mechanic Badges with Driver M-Bar and W-Bar.

After retiring from the military in 1997, he drove a log truck for five years, a flat-bed for twelve years, and now he drives for himself as an Owner/Operator.

Reverend Rodgers was baptized at an early age, grew up in the church, and has given his life to Jesus Christ. Without any hesitation or reservation, he accepted the call to "Preach the Word". He is part of a third generation of preachers, his grandfather was a preacher, and his uncle, in his own generation; his oldest brother and sister are preachers. So, his family is rooted in the Word.

He is practiced and ordained and is actively engaged in the Christian Education, Missions, and Benevolence of the General Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, the Roanoke Missionary Baptist Association, and the Albemarle Union of Northeastern North Carolina. He is the Pastor of Weeping Mary Missionary Baptist Church, Jamesville, NC where he just celebrated his tenth (10th) year as Pastor.

He has been a guest revivalist, for several years, and is often called upon to deliver the Sunday morning message at neighboring churches and throughout the community. He is also in continuous growth in his relationship with Christ. He has completed two semesters at the Roanoke Theological Seminary. He is a graduate of the Shaw University Divinity School at the Roanoke Collegiate Institute. And he continues to be schooled and used by God. He's a remarkable story teller and loves to see God's people smile.

He is celebrating thirty-six years of marriage with Kim. From this union they have five successful children; Keala, Gabrielle, Gregory Jr., Isaac, and M'Kayla, and two grandchildren; Khailani (13) and Kingsley (3). And he is very proud of all of them.
